Cobaltite is a relatively common arsenide-sulfide mineral found in certain hydrothermal vein deposits often in association with silver and other cobalt and nickel arsenide minerals. Northern Peninsula.

Baraga County: The Huron River uranium prospect, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ section 1, T51N, R30W: As microscopic grains associated with mercurian silver. First Michigan occurrence. Verified by energy and wavelength dispersion X-ray spectrometry.
