

## **EDENITE**



One of the calcic amphiboles, occurring chiefly in marbles and skarns, but also in certain other metamorphic and igneous rocks. Northern Peninsula.

**Dickinson County:** Hardwood - Foster City area: Based on the electron microprobe analyses reported for two "hornblendes" occurring in the Hardwood Gneiss (Peterson and Geiger, 1990), these amphiboles are actually edenite.
