

LAVENDULAN



An uncommon chlor-arsenate mineral found in the oxide zones of certain copper deposits. Northern Peninsula.

Keweenaw County: Reported as a rare species at the Mohawk mines with a variety of arsenides and arsenates (Morris, 1983). The mineral “freirinite” previously reported from the Mohawk mines has been shown to be lavendulan (P. B. Moore, personal communication).
