


## METATYUYAMUNITE



A supergene uranium mineral. Northern Peninsula.

**Baraga County:** Huron River prospect, NW ¼ NW ¼ section 1, T51N, R30W: Metatyuyamunite occurs with volborthite (q.v.), calcite and “pitchblende” in a brecciated quartz vein (thrust fault) exposed in the bank of the Huron River (East branch) near, and upstream from the falls (Kalliokoski, 1976).

**Iron County:** Reported by Vickers (1956b) with other supergene uranium minerals, various sulfides, and pitchblende at the Buck iron mine.
