

WOLLASTONITE



Monroe County: Wollastonite has been found as splintery white cleavage masses associated with clinopyroxene and garnet in a glacial erratic excavated from a 1990s housing project in the SW ¼ NE ¼ section 25, T6S, R8E (M. Heilman, personal communication, 2007). Verified by X-ray diffraction and energy dispersion X-ray spectrometry.
