

DYSCRASITE



An uncommon species usually found in hydrothermal veins with other silver minerals. Northern Peninsula.

Marquette County: Ropes gold mine, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ section 29, T48N, R27W: Dyscrasite occurs as a rare accessory mineral in some of the gold-bearing quartz veins (Bornhorst et al., 1999).
