

## MASLOVITE



Maslovite is a rare platinum-bearing mineral found in certain layered igneous intrusive deposits such as Noril'sk in Russia, and the Bushveld complex in South Africa. Its occurrence in Michigan may be the first reported for the United States, and only the third in the world. Northern Peninsula.

**Baraga County:** Bell Resources' A-Train project, approximately 8 km southeast of Alberta: As blebs in drill core associated with the magmatic ore minerals pyrite, chalcopyrite, pyrrhotite and magnetite hosted in magmatically derived hornblendite (Bell Resources, 2007).
