


PYROCHLORE



Pyrochlore is just one species within a larger mineral group of the same name. It is regularly found both in carbonatite and granitic pegmatite occurrences worldwide. Northern Peninsula.

Dickinson County: Small, unnamed pegmatite in SW ¼ SE ¼ section 30, T42N, R29W: Electron microprobe analyses of heavy mineral separates from this pegmatite have confirmed the presence of a uranium-enriched pyrochlore (Buchholz et al., 2013a).
